# **Application for County Franchise**

(Chapter 6.20 of Sacramento County Code)





A current, valid County (County) Franchise for Commercial Solid Waste Collection is required for non-exclusive commercial solid waste collection, transportation, and disposal services in the unincorporated areas of Sacramento County.

County Franchise Application review process is as follows:

- 1. Applicant submits completed application and all attachments to: commercialwaste@saccounty.net
- 2. New applicant submits non-refundable \$1,000 application fee to the County.
- 3. Applicants will be notified of either: A) Recommendation to Board of Supervisors to grant a franchise; B) Incomplete application; or C) Denial.
  - A. If application is recommended for County Board approval, the franchise shall be effective when the applicant and the County sign the written agreement.
  - B. The applicant will be notified if the application is incomplete and identify what information or materials the application is missing.
  - C. The applicant will be notified of the reason(s) why the application was denied.

#### **SECTION 4 – DIVERSION PLAN**

Franchisees are required to provide education, outreach, and technical assistance to ensure commercial generator recycling compliance as required by Section 6.20.285 of Sacramento County Code, as well as AB 341, AB 1826, and SB 1383 state compliance requirements. Franchisees are required to submit a Diversion Plan to the County on an annual basis with this application.

**Complete Attachment 2 -** Annual Diversion Plan Template and attach to the completed application.

#### **SECTION 5 – VEHICLE INVENTORY & INSPECTIONS**

#### A. Vehicle Inventory

Franchisees are required to submit its Commercial Solid Waste Vehicle Inventory Form on an annual basis. **Complete Attachment 3 -** Vehicle Inventory Form and attach to the completed application.

#### **B.** Annual Vehicle Inspections

All Franchisee vehicles shall be inspected by Sacramento County Environmental Management Department (EMD) before they may be used for commercial solid waste operations. EMD will contact Franchisee to schedule an appointment for vehicle inspections. A per vehicle inspection cost will be charged.

A vehicle franchise decal for each vehicle that has passed an inspection will be mailed to applicant and must be affixed to the vehicle. It is illegal for any vehicle not clearly displaying this decal to collect commercial solid waste in the unincorporated areas of the County.

**Note:** Any change in the vehicle inventory during the term of the franchise agreement, such as adding a new truck, must be reported on a revised Commercial Solid Waste Vehicle Inventory form. Email the revised form to <a href="mailto:commercialwaste@saccounty.net">commercialwaste@saccounty.net</a>. New vehicles must be inspected by EMD before being put into service.

#### **SECTION 6 – INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS**

Franchisees are required to provide a valid Certificate of Insurance (COI) showing proof of adequate coverages as required in Attachment 4. A valid and adequate COI must be submitted as part of the application.

# SECTION 7 – FINANCIAL REVIEW (new applications only)

Applicants must provide satisfactory proof to the County that the applicant has adequate financial resources to conduct commercial solid waste collection services.

Examples of satisfactory proof include: an Irrevocable Letter of Credit; or a vehicle refundable cash deposit to the County of \$500 for each of the vehicles identified in applicant's Vehicle Inventory Form, as discussed in Section 5 above.

## **SECTION 8 – JUDGEMENTS**

Chapter 6.20.245 B.4 of Sacramento County Code requires that a complete listing and explanation of any civil or criminal rulings or judgments in excess of five-thousand dollars (\$5,000), or convictions against applicant, or any of applicant's partners, major stockholders (stockholder owning 10% or more of company), or corporate directors of parent or subsidiary companies. I hereby certify that the information in this application package is true and correct, that the operation will be conducted in accordance with the information contained and certified herein, and in accordance with Chapter 6.20 of Sacramento County Code. Further, I hereby certify that I have access to suitable facilities for keeping vehicles and equipment clean and in good repair, and that I own or will have access to reasonable local office, and billing facilities.

I hereby certify that the company(s) attests conformity with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles in accounting practices; obligation to insurance and indemnification requirements of all County contractual partners including franchisees; and commitment to the compliance with the requirements of the franchise agreement, including timely submittal of fees and reports.

I hereby certify that I owe no outstanding fees of any kind to the County nor are there any federal or state tax liens filed against me or any property I own.
